**Admission Policy for**  
**Nursery Class of St Mary's RC Primary School**

St Mary's is a non-denominational Nursery. It will offer 52 part-time places to pupils in their pre-school year, that is, the school year in which they attain their fourth birthday.

The places will be part-time (morning or afternoon).

Decisions on admissions will be made by the end of the January preceding the September of admission.

In allocating places, the following criteria will be used in order of precedence:

1. Baptised Catholic children permanently resident in the parishes of St Mary's Cullercoats, Our Lady and St. Oswin's, Tynemouth and St. Edmund's, Backworth. Or attending mass on a regular basis in one of these parishes with a letter of support from the appropriate Parish Priest.
2. Other children with older brothers or sisters who are registered pupils at the school on the date on which decisions are made and who will continue to attend on 1st September of the admission year.
3. Other children who live within the area bounded by The Broadway, Beach Road, Preston Road North, and the previous boundary of the County Borough of Tynemouth.
4. Other pupils who are resident outside of the area defined in 3 above.

It is possible that there will be more children in category 3 or 4 than there are places available at the school. In this case, places will be offered in accordance with the above prioritised categories on the basis of the position of a child's name on a waiting list held at the school. (Names will be held on the waiting list in strict order of parents placing children on the list.)

**Note:**

Admission to the nursery class cannot guarantee admission to the reception class, nor can attendance at the nursery be taken as establishing any claim on places at the school outside the school's normal admission policy. The admission policy for the Reception class will be kept under review by the Governing Body.

It is the sole responsibility of the parent to ensure their child's application has been successfully returned and received by the school.
